NPR Crew Cab Advantages Over Ford F-350 Crew Cab



Hino 145:

- Hino sells a line of short-nose conventional trucks covering the same weight categories and customer needs as the N-Series trucks
- 145 is 14,050 lb. GVWR competing against NPR
- No gas engine available in Hino trucks
- 5-year/175,000-mile powertrain warranty



NPR Advantages:

- Available gas engine has more than twice the power of the Hino diesel and offers lower initial cost and lighter weight for greater payload (gas engine not available on 145)
- Hino weighs approximately 1000 lb. more than the diesel NPR due to the conventional cab design. This requires a higher GVWR for Hino than a comparable Isuzu. Gas engine NPR weighs more than 1400 lb. less than Hino
- Both trucks offer four wheelbase choices, but NPR's longest wheelbase provides 9.4 inches greater available CA for longer body capacity
- Higher torque output with manual transmission (441 lb.-ft. vs. 376 lb.-ft.) improves load carrying and towing
- Higher diesel horsepower output (205 hp vs. 175 hp) helps get work done faster
- 6-speed automatic vs. 4-speed automatic contributes to fuel efficiency and performance
- Tighter turning diameter (curb-to-curb) for comparable cab-to-axle (33.5 ft./109.0 in. WB vs. 35.1 ft./114.6 in. WB) improves maneuverability
- Higher front-axle capacity (6830 lb. vs. 5510 lb.) contributes to durability
- Tilt cab allows easy engine access (limited engine access on Hino)
- Higher rear-axle capacity contributes to durability in commercial operation (11,020 lb. vs. 9,880 lb.)
- Wider door opening for easy entry and exit (85 degree vs. 70 degree)
- Standard front stabilizer bar vs. optional on Hino
- All-season front and rear radial tires provide optimum mix of traction and mileage (highwayfront and traction-rear radials on 145)
